


## St Mary's Superstars - Weekly creative challenges

<p>We are making our very own 'Covid Cobra' in our school garden. Find a stone while out and about and paint it or decorate it however you would like. You can add them to our snake in the garden and let's see how long it grows!</p> 	<p>Collect some different leaves with different textures e.g. some rough, some smooth. Place a piece of paper over each and, using a crayon or pencil, make a leaf rubbing. You could also paint the leaves and print the patterns onto some paper.</p> 	<p>DIY ring toss. Tape a kitchen roll tube (or another tube) to a paper plate and make sure it is secure. Cut out the central circle of more paper plates and decorate them in bright colours. Try to throw the rings until they land around the tube. You could give points for each and keep score!</p> 	<p>Make a garden in a jar. Start with a small layer of rocks at the bottom of your container. Fill the container up to half-full with soil. Plant your seeds or plants. Leave some space for them to breathe and grow. Add decorative pebbles, rocks, pine cones, or whatever to make your jar look like a little garden world.</p> 	<p>Make a mask that transforms you into your favourite character from a book, film or TV show. You could use a paper plate, some card or even a box. You might want to make a hat or a crown and attach them to a stick instead of a mask.</p>
